**Title:** MRI Safety / Risk Management: Liability & Regulation

**Description:**

This program will review the current safety, regulatory and legal liability climate in the US with respect to MRI services, reflecting on industry changes (or lack thereof) in the past 10 years.

**Objectives:**

- Outline the divergent trends of each MRI safety regulation and the rates of MRI accidents.
- Define who, even if they're off-site at the time of an accident, is principally liable for accidents in MRI.
- Identify the three most reported sources of MRI accident and injury, and be provided with specific action items capable of mitigating nearly 90% of these accidents.

**Speaker: Tobias Gilk, M. Arch. President & MRI Safety Director, Mednovus, Inc.**

Tobias Gilk is an architect by training, but has been working in MRI safety for the last decade, both as a designer and for a manufacturer of MRI safety products. He has served on the American College of Radiology's MRI Safety Committee (the only architect to ever serve on that committee) and is an outspoken advocate for safe, effective and efficient MRI services. In addition to his volunteer work for the ACR, he has also provided MRI safety training services for Joint Commission surveyors, contributed to most contemporary MRI design and construction standards, and speaks internationally on a variety of MRI and radiology safety topics.
